What is Little Shots?

Little Shots Day Camp is designed especially for younger children who have diabetes. Intermingled with the educational sessions are fun-filled themed recreational activities, games, and arts and crafts. All activities are designed to promote confidence and teach techniques for managing their diabetes.



Children value the opportunity to spend an entire week with 35 other children and positive teen role models who also have diabetes. For a short time, your child won't feel like the "only one" who has diabetes! Kids leave camp with a "can do" attitude and new friends they will treasure for life!

Nearly 90% of parents report that their child needs fewer reminders to perform self-care tasks after spending a week at camp.

Campers, parents, and extended family come together to celebrate each camper's achievements at the family picnic and awards ceremony on Thursday evening, July 30th.

Registration

Pre-Register: Online at www.dys4kids.org. Credit card and electronic checking also available online, or complete a pre-registration form and mail with payment to our office. Several other forms needed can be downloaded from the webpage or we will mail them to you after we receive your child's pre-registration.

Camper Fees: \$175 per camper if registered on or before June 15, 2009 and \$200 if registered after June 15. Please call the DYS office for information about paying the camp fee in installments if needed.

Your child's camp fee represents only a small portion of the actual cost, which exceeds \$700 per camper. DYS fundraising events along with funding from community partners and individuals allow us to keep camp fees as affordable as possible.

Camp Physical: Schedule with your child's pediatrician right away!

Physical, Diabetes Management, and Consent Forms Due July 1, 2009. **START EARLY!**

Financial Assistance is available to **ANYONE** in need. Camp Scholarships will be awarded on a sliding scale based on income. Ask for a Financial Assistance Application & brochure with financial assistance tips when you pre-register your child. **Applications must be turned in complete and with supporting tax documents by June 1, 2009.**

Final Deadline: July 1, 2009

Space is limited, your child will be put on the waiting list or unable to attend if you have not turned everything in on time.
