To Whom it May Concern:

_____ has been diagnosed with Type 1 Juvenile Diabetes.

This is a chronic medical condition which requires:

- Multiple daily doses of insulin
- Monitoring of blood glucose levels before meals and as needed
- Treatment of low blood sugar immediately
- Monitoring of urine ketones (as Doctor orders)
- Following a flexible meal plan which involves counting all carbohydrates eaten and includes several snacks a day
- Access to diabetes supplies (blood glucose meter, insulin, glucagon, etc...) and access to food or beverages to treat low blood sugar **at all times.**
- Access to a restroom facility
- Access to water

Please do not leave this student alone when not feeling well. Please contact this student's care team when the student is having symptoms or not feeling well.

If you have questions or concerns about having a type 1 student in your classroom, please contact Diabetes Youth Services. Diabetes Youth Services will provide a teacher/staff in-service to help alleviate any questions or fears you (or other staff members) may have regarding type 1 diabetes.
